## Utah Valley Parade of Homes Facts

- The 40<sup>th</sup> annual Utah Valley Parade of Homes.
- The parade is hosted by the Utah Valley Home Builder Association.
- The event will take place from June 8-24.
- Attendees can visit 31 different homes throughout Utah County during a two week period.
- Homes are open during the two-week event, Tuesday through Saturday from 12-9 p.m.
- The event is a self-guided tour of newly constructed homes that are professionally designed.
- The homes start range from \$400,000 to over \$2 million.
- The sized of the homes range from 2029 to 12,931 square feet.
- For the first time, a 'Wolverine House' will be featured in the parade. A Wolverine House is the name of the home UVHBA uses to raise money for a UVU scholarship.
- Addresses of the homes can be found on the Utah Valley Parade app or at [uvparade.com](http://uvparade.com).
- The Parade of Homes is the UVHBA's largest revenue builder.
- In 2016, over 25,000 people attended the parade of homes.
- The first Utah Valley Parade of Homes was in 1977
- Tickets are \$15 per person, and children under the age of five receive free admission.

  - Osmond Designs in Orem and Lehi
  - Central Bank locations in Springville, Mapleton, Spanish Fork and Payson
- Osmond Designs and Universal Furniture will be giveaway a living room set. One can enter by presenting their ticket to the front desk at either the Orem or Lehi Osmond Designs. Those who attend more than 10 houses are eligible to be entered twice. Last day to entire is June 26 and the winner will be announced on June 28.
- Every year for the past 10 years, UVHBA and the homebuilders construct a home known as the 'Cougar House.' The finished home is sold and all the proceeds are donated for a BYU scholarship. Last year was the first year that a 'Wolverine House' was built for UVU students.
