Facts about the Utah Valley Parade of Homes

- The 2019 event is the 44th annual Utah Valley Parade of Homes
- The parade is hosted by the Utah Valley Home Builders Association (UVHBA)
- The event takes place June 6-22
- Homes are open Tuesday through Saturday from noon to 9 p.m.
- The event is a self-guided tour of newly constructed, professionally designed homes
- Attendees can visit 40 different homes throughout Utah County during a two-and-a-half-week period
- Tickets are \$16 per person and are required for all attendees who are 5-years and older
- Tickets can be purchased at uvparade.com, on the Parade of Homes mobile app, at either Osmond Designs locations, at any Central Bank location.
- Home values range from \$450,000 to over \$5 million
- Home sizes range from 2,500 to over 22,000 square feet
- Addresses of the homes will be available on June 6 and can be found at uvparade.com, on the Utah Valley Parade mobile app, or on the map inside the Parade of Homes magazine on opening day
- In 2018, more than 28,000 people attended the Parade of Homes
- The first Utah Valley Parade of Homes took place in 1975
- In connection with the event, Osmond Designs and Central Bank—the two Title Sponsors of the 2019 Utah Valley Parade of Homes—are both offering special incentives during the parade. Central Bank is giving away a free Little Giant Ladder to anyone who either closes a home loan with them or refers a home loan that closes. Osmond Designs is offering a 25 percent discount off of one accessory item. More information regarding these specials can be obtained from the respective sponsor
- UVHBA distributes scholarships to students majoring in construction management at BYU, UVU and Snow College.
- For more than 10 years, the Utah Valley Parade of Homes has featured homes built and sold to benefit students at Brigham Young University and Utah Valley University. These homes are referred to as a 'Cougar Home' or a 'Wolverine Home' respectively. All proceeds of the homes are used for student scholarships. While this year's parade does not feature a Cougar Home or Wolverine Home, a Cougar Home is currently under construction
